# **Post Event Report**

It was wonderful to see the key stakeholders in the UK's solar industry come together for the first UK Solar Summit event in London, and participate in such an enthusiastic and unified way.

The UK solar market is going through a period of rapid change: driven by global climate change; aligned with long-term national net-zero targets; meeting the demands of the private sector to reduce reliance on fossil fuels and price volatility; and being part of low-cost renewables as the basis of the future energy mix.

There have been many solar and renewables gatherings (events, conferences, exhibitions) in the UK over the past decade and there have been plenty of opinions offered for all to hear. Perhaps however the recent UK Solar Summit was the first true keynote presentation-based event that has held an audience so captive with market intelligence, observations and findings - from start to finish.

To this end, I would like to thank all speakers and panellists that contributed to the event. Behind the scenes, leading up to the event, our team spent considerable time with each of the speakers on the topics, scope and make-up of the final slide-decks. From the feedback I got at the event, and since then, I think you would agree this was entirely worth the time and went a long way to making the event such a success.

The UK has now installed about 16 GWp-dc and there is widespread support for this tripling by 2030; something that may well end up a cautious underestimate. How the UK solar industry adds sufficient annual deployment levels (both on rooftops and ground-mount) to meet long-term aspirations will remain the basis of the topics, keynote speakers and panel discussions at future UK Solar Summits.

Making sure we get this right, and maximize the value of the UK Solar Summit, is critical. We would be delighted to get your feedback and ideas over the coming months before welcoming everyone back to London in June 2023 for the next event.
