

To access them typically requires an experienced partner that knows what value streams are available and how to participate.




To participate in all value streams, battery capacity must be intelligently allocated for different use cases daily. It is key to be in the right place at the right time.

Example of how frequency has changed in 12 months










Average contracted volumes in DC, DM and DR (MW)




Average availability payments in DC, DM and DR (GBP/MW/h)
